COMEX Bus Service Expands in Quispamsis

Quispamsis, NB Tuesday, July 27, 2010: Just hop on the bus! Residents of Quispamsis now have two routes to choose from - the Quispamsis COMEX 53 and the existing KV COMEX 52. Saint John Transit will launch its newest bus service, the Quispamsis COMEX 53 starting Tuesday, August 3.

Subsidized by the town of Quispamsis, the new route will offer commuters express transit service directly to and from the City of Saint John. "We want to encourage residents to use public transportation as this is a great way to save money, reduce pollution and traffic congestion." said Emil Olsen, Deputy Mayor, Quispamsis, and chair of the COMEX Committee.

The Quispamsis COMEX 53 will travel along Vincent Road and continue on the Gondola Point Arterial, stop at the Parkside Road Park & Ride Lot, then travel directly into Saint John via Highway One.

Three Park & Ride locations will be situated on the new route:

1. Rothesay Baptist Church on Vincent Road
2. Homestar Dog Park (temporary location until qplex opens)
3. Parkside Road Park & Ride Lot

There will also be two other stops on the Vincent Road at Legend Lane and near Alderbrook Drive.

"Ridership on the COMEX bus service in the Kennebecasis Valley has been steadily increasing since its inception in September 2007." explains Frank McCarey, Saint John Transit General Manager. "This expansion was a timely addition to complement our transit system."
