Quispamsis, NB Thursday, November 25, 2010: There has been much discussion recently surrounding the circumstances of two dogs that have been impounded by the Town of Quispamsis.

The town is responsible for ensuring the public health, safety and well-being of its residents and responded accordingly to a situation. Since June 2010, we have received six separate complaints regarding the dogs, two of which involved biting. The matter has now been brought before the New Brunswick Provincial Court and a trial date has been set for January 12, 2011. The facts and information that support the town's decision to bring this forward to the courts will come out at the trial.

Presently the Town of Quispamsis is making every effort to ensure the well-being of the two dogs. The dogs are being boarded at a reputable facility, where they are residing indoors in a safe and healthy environment. They are being well cared for, receiving proper attention, exercise, food and water and appropriate veterinarian care as needed. The dogs will remain at this facility until there has been a ruling on their disposition by the Provincial Court.
