AMENDMENT NO. 018-10

**TO BY-LAW NO. 018 OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF QUISPAMISIS RESPECTING THE
REMUNERATION OF COUNCIL**

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of Quispamsis that By-law No. 018, a By-law of the Municipality of Quispamsis Respecting the Remuneration of Council is hereby amended as follows:

1. By adding immediately after Section 3.A. the following:

B. “a review by staff of the compensation amounts set out in Section 3.A. shall be conducted in the year preceding a municipal election.”
2. By adding immediately after Section 4.B.i. the following:

ii “All members shall adhere to Quispamsis staff travel policy P2025-002 and amendments thereto”
3. By adding immediately after Section 4 C the following:

D. An individual Councillor, Deputy Mayor or Mayor may exceed their individual expense allocation by a maximum of 20% subject to there being prior written approval by the Mayor, (Deputy Mayor in the event the Mayor is making the request) and Chief Administrative Officer and provided the total approved budget for reimbursement for expenses will not be exceeded.
4. By adding at the end of Section 5.1.A. the following sentence. “Notwithstanding the foregoing, the maximum CPI annual adjustment will be 5%.
