- Follow all safety protocols as identified in the town's safety manual, including reporting any safety concerns to management.
- Attend work on a scheduled and regular basis.
- Perform other labour duties as designated by management necessary to the operation of the department.

Essential Qualifications:

- Completion of Grade 12 education and/or equivalent.
- Valid Class 5 driver's license or higher and a clean driving record.
- Current First Aid/CPR and WHMIS Training considered to be an asset.
- Ability to operate small equipment including mowers, skid steers and asset.
- Understand the critical customer service role of municipal employees
- Ability to work independently; be innovative, resourceful and accountable.
- Proven ability to cooperatively, efficiently and effectively provide quality customer service to internal and external customers, the public and other agencies.

Working Conditions:

- Regular 80 hours bi-weekly.
- Work primarily outdoors.
